Stations of the Cross – it is now some time that the great artist Carmel Cauchi offered to create Stations of the Cross for the church in ES as his last work. This was presented to the Finance Committee and PC who agreed to send the proposal to the diocese for approval, which has now been granted. The cost of this project - £14,000 – will be met from a legacy left to the parish some years ago and now lodged in our diocesan set-off account. No present parish funds will be necessary. It was thought that this would be a worthy way of commemorating the donor. Mr. Cauchi has been seriously ill but has now recovered so we hope he can complete the work. Unless anyone has a vehement objection, we will formally ask him to proceed.

Safeguarding Information – anyone within our parish communities who works with children, elderly people or vulnerable adults is required by law to have a DBS certificate, which needs to be renewed from time to time.
