There are also thousands of people left injured, bereaved and homeless, and the need for some form of response is immediate. For this reason there will be a special retiring collection next weekend for the Disasters Emergency Committee to cover both tragedies. This will replace other proposed fund-raising events then. The Earl Shilton Finance Committee have asked that the amount collected be matched from parish funds, and all the money collected from the three parishes will be sent directly to the DEC on Monday 24th.
