Once we have gathered this information, we will begin the programme before the end of the year which will involve meeting in Earl Shilton on most Monday evenings from 6.15-7.30pm and taking part in various activities in our parishes.

Family Fast Day – takes place on Friday October 6th. Envelopes will be distributed next weekend and may be returned the following week.
