November Dead List – is now published in all three parishes. The Masses will be said throughout the year and the names will remain in our churches throughout the coming month. Let us never forget our dear ones nor those who have no one to remember them.

Remembrance Sunday – today is the day for remembering our dead – those who have died in war and our own families and friends. There will be Memorial services in Earl Shilton and Market Bosworth on Sunday morning.

Service for Deceased Parishioners – of all three parishes takes place this evening at 6.00pm in Hinckley, beginning in the church grounds at the graves of those whose ashes are buried there. You may light a candle at the grave which will be blessed at the beginning. We then gather in church for our service during which the names of all those who have died in the past 10 years will be read out (the others are named in our Books of Remembrance which will be presented at the altar) and an opportunity will be provided for everyone to light a candle for their relatives afterwards. Do please come along for this very moving occasion. There will be a cup of tea afterwards in the centre
