Help for the Ukraine - Join us on Friday, February 2, at 2:30 pm at The Frassati Centre, Holy Cross Priory, 45 Wellington St, Leicester LE1 6HW for a Homes for Ukraine gathering hosted by SJOG and CSAN. Nearly two years since the full-scale invasion of Ukraine, the number of those still wishing to evacuate and find refuge in the UK continues to be high. SJOG Homes for Ukraine is a programme run by St John of God Hospitaller Services (SJOG) in partnership with Caritas Social Action Network (CSAN). We support people on their journey and provide opportunities to integrate into community life in the UK. We will discuss the current situation in Ukraine and why there is still a pressing need for people to come forward and host families from Ukraine. This is a great opportunity to learn about Ukrainian refugees in the UK and ask any questions you might have.
