Lent 2024 – Lent will be starting in two weeks and we would like to consider once again two weekly activities to mark it: a Frugal Lunch in the Mary Forryan Centre after Friday mid-day Mass and Stations of the Cross in our respective churches on Sunday evenings at 6.00pm. Stations of the Cross will be in Market Bosworth on February 18th and March 10th, Earl Shilton , February 23rd (Friday) and March 17th and Hinckley on March 3rd and 24th.

Ash Wednesday – Masses for Ash Wednesday (February 14th) will be as follows: Hinckley – 9.30am (with St.Peter's School) and 6.30pm; Market Bosworth 12.00pm; Earl Shilton – at St.Peter's School, Mill Lane at 9.30am) Ashes will be blessed and distributed at all Masses.

Foodbank in Lent – our local Foodbank have devised an ingenious scheme to encourage us not just to 'give up' something for Lent but to give something away instead. There are leaflets suggesting what you might want to give up each day and then bring to our collection point in Hinckley or to local supermarkets.
