Food Collection for Ukraine – will take place at our Market Bosworth church on Wednesday and Thursday, February 14th and 15th from 10.00am-6.00pm. You may drop off food items at the front porch of the church

Lent 2024 – Lent starts this week with the Masses on Ash Wednesday (see above). There will also be a series of services and activities for us to undertake during the next few weeks:

Stations of the Cross will be in Market Bosworth on February 18th and March 10th, Earl Shilton, February 23rd (Friday) and March 17th and Hinckley on March 3rd and 24th. We hope you will be willing to 'travel' to see each church and be part of its community for these events. If any group would like to lead the stations, please see one of the priests.

Eucharistic Services and Stations of the Cross – on Thursdays in Earl Shilton at 10.00am beginning on February 22nd

Frugal Lunches – in aid of CAFOD, each Friday in the Mary Forryan Centre after 12.00pm Mass. If anyone would like to make soup and a roll please let the priests know. Some students from St. Martin's will be joining us to help at Mass and serving the soup from March 1st.

Foodbank in Lent – our local Foodbank have devised an ingenious scheme to encourage us not just to 'give up' something for Lent but to give something away instead. There are leaflets suggesting what you might want to give up each day and then bring to our collection point in Hinckley or to local supermarkets.

Walk with Me books – we hope to have these available for sale next weekend.

Cafod projects – on the weekend of February 17/18 envelopes for Family Fast Day (23rd) will be distributed (and collected the following weekend) along with boxes you can take home to use throughout Lent and bring back to be collected on April 13/14

World Day of Prayer – Friday March 1st. Services (prepared by the women of Palestine) will take place in the Baptist Chapel in Earl Shilton and at our own Market Bosworth church on that day at 2.00pm – all welcome.

Mass Intentions – apart from our Dead List, we have now completely run out of Mass intentions. If you would like a Mass said for your intentions or a deceased relative or friend, please place your offering in an envelope with the intention clearly marked and hand it in to the sacristy or the Priory, and we will endeavour to say the Mass for you as soon as possible.
