The Funeral for Mrs.Annette Sellars – will take place in Hinckley on Monday at mid-day. St.Martin’s School will be closed for the day and we hope that many students in uniform will join staff to commemorate a loyal and loving teacher who died so tragically only a few weeks ago. Special arrangements will have to be made to accommodate the numbers of people coming. The church car park will be closed to all traffic after 9.30am. Parents may come to drop off their children for school and pre-school as normal but should leave the car park immediately afterwards. St.Peter’s School staff can use the overflow car park at the back of the centre for the day. Staff from St.Martin’s school will be coming in minibuses from the school having formed a guard of honour outside the school when Annette’s coffin is driven past on her way to church. The service takes place at 12.00noon and a reception will follow in the Mary Forryan Centre until 3.15pm when the coffin will be taken from church for a private cremation. Parents wishing to pick up their children from St.Peter’s School may do so only after 3.15pm when the cortege has left. We hope that the whole event will be a dignified and grateful send off for a lovely lady and that it will bring comfort to her family and friends at this very difficult time.
