**The extension to our Hinckley church** – we are all aware of the plans that have been in place for the last few years to extend our church at the front in order to enable people to gather safely before and after Masses and so that the work to reach out to people in need both near and far can take place in a warm and dry space. There were also serious health and safety issues regarding the fact that the four main doors from the interior of the church funnel into two doors, which normally would not be too much of a problem but given large events like the funeral last Monday and our slowly increasing Sunday congregation have become a significant issue, which we can no longer ignore. Much of the project was interrupted by the pandemic but we have patiently and professionally proceeded to the present situation. Last Wednesday, our Hinckley Finance Committee (which also has a representative from Earl Shilton) voted unanimously to accept one of three tenders to undertake the work and this will now be submitted to the diocese for ratification. Once this hopefully has happened, we can then proceed to working out how and when the work can take place, maybe even over this coming summer and sorting out what modifications need to be made to ensure safe access to our church. A very sincere thank you to Andy Page, our surveyor, and his son Daniel, the architect, for their tireless and generous work in bringing the project to its present stage, and we all hope that we can move forward together to produce a building that is suitable for our purpose in the coming years. It is important that you all know the progress that has been made to this stage, rather than finding out from elsewhere, hence our statement today. Much has to happen yet and there are a lot of hoops to jump through but we all hope and pray that we can bring the project into being in the near future.

**Thank you** – to everyone who played any part in arranging the beautiful funeral for Mrs. Sellars last Monday, and also to all those who quietly come to help with reading, welcoming and preparing all of our churches for any celebration whatever that might be. Your kindness and faithfulness are much appreciated. Thank you also to those who returned CAFOD boxes and to parishioners who supported our young people from St. Martin's School to the tune of £1,016 in their 'sleep out' last weekend, and this will be donated with the rest of the monies gathered to Lawrence House, whose representatives came to speak to us most impressively at the beginning of the event.

The preparation will take place with our Sunshine Club on Thursday evenings fortnightly from 6.30-8.30pm beginning in January. This is an innovation which we hope will be fruitful for everyone concerned. All young people who are regular practicing members of our community and who will be in Year 8 and upwards from this September are eligible to make application.
