**The extension to our Hinckley church** – last Monday, the diocese gave formal permission for us to begin work on the project to extend the front of our church. Most elements are already in place and if all goes well, work might be able to commence soon. The project is estimated to last 16-18 weeks and the ideal scenario would be for a good deal of this to take place during the summer holidays which would give us the space and time to make a good start. Clearly there will be quite a bit of upheaval and we need to ensure there is proper access to the church, room for coffins to be taken in and out, and all the necessary safety requirements to be put in place. We are also concerned that our children in the pre-school, and St. Peter's School will be able to carry on their normal activities in safety and security. There will of course also be implications for parking in the church car park and adjustments will have to be made. We ask for your patience and co-operation in this matter. The Finance Committee will take the lead in decision making and we have asked Robin Brooks and Chris Sowman to be our representatives in working with the contractors and design team. We thank them both most warmly for their willingness to do this on our behalf. At this stage, any questions regarding the project may be addressed to Fr. Frank or Leo Burton, Chairman of our Finance Committee.
