Please make a special effort to come along to Mass to help us do so and to see off our pilgrims for this year. If you have any intentions you would like to be taken to Lourdes on your behalf, please write them on a piece of paper and place them in a sealed envelope (with no money) and they will be placed next to the Grotto by our pilgrims on Friday evening. Hopefully we can have some idea of the time, so that we can stop what we are doing and join them in prayer at that moment. This is a great occasion for thanksgiving and delight. Let us all share in it together.
