Dominican Memorial - Next weekend we will be holding our annual Dominican Memorial to remember our heritage and also the priests and sisters who lived and worked here for 234 years. There will be a brief service at the grave of Fr.Norton in Aston Flamville Cemetery at 9.00am and then at 11.00am a visit to the graves in Hinckley cemetery.
