Dominican Memorial - This weekend we will be holding our annual Dominican Memorial to remember our heritage and also the priests and sisters who lived and worked here for 234 years. There will be a brief service at the grave of Fr. Norton in Aston Flamville Cemetery at 9.00am and then at 11.00am a visit to the graves in Hinckley cemetery.

A Gathering Area - as you can see, work has now begun and the main entrance to the Hinckley church is closed. The foyer may be used for toilets and the shop for the next eight weeks with access from inside the church. If you consult the leaflet you were all given last weekend, you will be able to access the arrangements which are now in place. The main car park will be completely closed during the week (except for use by funeral vehicles) and open for Mass only at the weekends. Entrance to the church is via the corridor at the parish centre and blue badge vehicles may park in front of it. All the details are on the leaflet published last weekend.
