We are so blessed to have had them among us and their service has extended far beyond the school walls, bringing wisdom, kindness and common sense to many families and students who have experienced difficulty or sadness over these years. We surround them with our grateful prayers and good wishes for whatever the future might hold for them and thank them wholeheartedly for a wonderful service and devotion, which will never be forgotten.
