A Martyr for the Truth – the conclusion of the last sermon preached by Fr.Jerzy Popieluszko in Bydgoszcz on October 19 1984, on his way home from which he was kidnapped and murdered.

“I want you to know that I have only ever lived and stood for the truth. I want the world to know that. And if I must die violently, it is better to die while defending a worthwhile cause than sitting back, letting injustice take over, and refusing to take a stand against it. In the history of Christianity, we have many examples showing the extent to which the truth must be defended – quite simply to the end”

Saturday October 19th is the 40th anniversary of Fr.Jerzy's murder. We will be marking it during the evening Mass that day and by showing the DVD of the play about him, “Ksiadz”, which was presented here in 2011, the next day in the centre at 5.00pm.
