I am very sorry to tell you that Fr. Terry died peacefully last evening, rather sooner than we had originally thought. His condition deteriorated during the week and clearly he was nearing the end of his life, but his death during the evening Mass in Hinckley took us by surprise. He was surrounded by the love and prayers of several parishioner friends as is only right. I would like to take this opportunity to thank most sincerely all those people who have supported Father with meals and friendship for the past three and a half years and the last three weeks in particular. I know he appreciated it. I'm not sure how we will be able to celebrate his funeral during the present restriction period but we will do our best to accommodate everyone in one way or another and allow you to pay your respects to him. We remember a gentle pastor and a lovely man.

You will be pleased to know that the Earl Shilton church can now be opened for Mass, which will be tomorrow, Monday at 10.00am and next Sunday at 11.30am.
