**Cyclone in Africa** – we will all have seen the pictures of the devastating cyclone that has hit Mozambique and Zimbabwe in the last fortnight, which has affected more than 2.6 million people. The Disasters Emergency Committee, which brings together 14 leading UK aid agencies, including CAFOD, have set up an appeal for us to help, and the government has promised to match every £1 donated up to £2million. Accordingly, we will have a retiring collection this weekend to enable us to support the relief work. Cheques may be made payable to the DEC.

**Holy Week Schedule** – for the services and events of holy week in our three communities will be available next weekend. If you would like to help with reading, acting, or in any capacity, please see Fr. Frank "Widening the Circle of Love" – we hope to produce an interim document on the first weekend of May, detailing what is involved in moving forward together with less priests or even no priests. The burden of responsibility has become a very heavy one and it will be good to share it.
