Lent 2024 There are a number of events and activities:

Walk with Me books – for use during Lent on sale this weekend at £1 each

Stations of the Cross will be in Market Bosworth this evening at 6.00pm and March 10th, Earl Shilton February 23rd (Friday – because of next Sunday's Mass of Anointing) and March 17th and Hinckley on March 3rd and 24th. We hope you will be willing to 'travel' to see each church and be part of its community for these events. If any group would like to lead the stations, please see one of the priests.

Extra Mass and Stations – on Thursdays in Earl Shilton during Lent, Fr. John Lally has kindly agreed to celebrate Mass at 10.00am followed by a brief Stations of the Cross

Frugal Lunches – in aid of CAFOD, each Friday in the Mary Forryan Centre after 12.00pm Mass. If anyone would like to make soup and a roll please sign the list in the porch. Some students from St. Martin's will be joining us to help at Mass and serving the soup for one or two occasions.

Cafod projects – this weekend, envelopes for Family Fast Day (which is Friday this week) will be distributed and collected next weekend in the form of a retiring collection.) There are also boxes you can take home to use throughout Lent and bring back to be collected on April 13/14

CAFOD Stall – some of our Year 6 students are running a stall for CAFOD on the weekend of March 16/17. "Be spring ready by purchasing our hand-made, eco-friendly bird food. You can hang it in your garden or anywhere else appropriate. All the money we receive will go straight to CAFOD. The bird food is £1 per portion and with each one comes your own mini-recipe, so you can make your own portion of bird food.

Foodbank in Lent – our local Foodbank have devised an ingenious scheme to encourage us not just to 'give up' something for Lent but to give something away instead. There are leaflets suggesting what you might want to give up each day and then bring to our collection point in Hinckley or to local supermarkets.

Mass of Anointing and Tea – takes place next Sunday at 2.30pm kindly organised by our First Communion parents' group. There will be a gathering to make sandwiches and prepare the centre from 1.15pm and the children will meet in church with Fr. Frank at 1.30pm to prepare the Liturgy of the Mass.

World Day of Prayer – Friday March 1st. Services (prepared by the women of Palestine) will take place in the Baptist Chapel in Earl Shilton and at our own Market Bosworth church on that day both at 2.00pm – all welcome.

St Peter's Lourdes Group are celebrating their 50th year this year and there will be many events to mark the occasion, the first of which will be the 'Bingo Tea' next Saturday at 2.30 in MFC.
