Fr. John Daley RIP – we were very sad to hear on Monday of the death of Fr. John Daley, the parish priest of St. Joseph's, Leicester, who had been a priest for 56 years. He was well known as a speaker at various events like the Eucharistic Ministers' Renewal Days and his talks were always enlightening and inspiring. Several people have said that they could listen to him all day! While a member of the Rosminian Order, he was closely associated with the diocese, having also been the parish priest in Birstall. He took a great interest in SPANED, AlterNativity and the 'Mother Mary' concerts which his church hosted twice, and he was always most encouraging to brother priests, writing lovely letters to tell us how much he appreciated all we did. We will all truly miss him.
