Blessed Jerzy Popieluszko – Saturday October 19th is the 40th anniversary of the murder of Fr.Jerzy, an event which was to prove more than a little pivotal in the eventual fall of Communism in Eastern Europe. He has a very special place not only in the hearts of all Polish people but also in many people here, as we presented the play of the story of his life and death on the 25th anniversary of its premiere in 2011. The play, "Ksiadz", was written by Fr.Frank in 1985 and presented in West Bridgford, Nottingham in 1986. We hope to invite many of the local Polish community to share with us in the celebration of his anniversary at the evening Mass on Saturday October 19th, which we hope will be followed by a get-together organized by our Polish parishioners in the Mary Forryan. On Sunday afternoon at 4.00pm, the DVD of the production of 'Ksiadz' will be shown in the centre and we hope that many people will also come to that. If anyone would like to help with organizing the events, please see Fr.Frank or come to a brief meeting this evening in the Mary Forryan centre at 6.00pm.

Memorial for Fr.Terry – this week was the 4th anniversary of Fr.Terry's death. Today we will be having our parish Memorial at the 11.30am Mass followed by a visit to his memorial in the church grounds. Also after Mass on Sunday you will have the last opportunity to take some of Fr.Terry's goods and furniture which have been stored in the garage. We will have to get rid of the rest of the items if we cannot find a home for them.

First Communion Information – A letter from your priests has been distributed to families from Year 4 and upwards in our schools with details of what is required for this to happen next year and the date for applications to be sent in by letter. If you children are not at our schools, then please collect a letter from us today. The programme is due to begin for parents and children on Monday December 2nd.

It would be a good thing if, at some stage, we could set up a Climate change group in our parishes to monitor developments and keep us all aware of what we need to be doing to avoid what threatens to be disaster on a global scale.
