Blessed Jerzy Popieluszko – Saturday October 19th is the 40th anniversary of the murder of Fr. Jerzy, an event which was to prove more than a little pivotal in the eventual fall of Communism in Eastern Europe. He has a very special place not only in the hearts of all Polish people but also in many people here, as we presented the play of the story of his life and death on the 25th anniversary of its premiere in 2011. The play, "Ksiadz", was written by Fr. Frank in 1985 and presented in West Bridgford, Nottingham in 1986. We hope to invite many of the local Polish community to share with us in the celebration of his anniversary at the normal evening Mass on Saturday October 19th, which we hope will be followed by a get-together organized by our Polish parishioners in the Mary Forryan Centre. On Sunday afternoon at 4.00pm, the DVD of the production of 'Ksiadz' will be shown in the centre and we hope that many people will also come to that. If anyone would like to help with organizing the events, please see Fr. Frank.

First Communion Information – A letter from your priests has been distributed to families from Year 4 and upwards in our schools with details of what is required for this to happen next year and the date for applications to be sent in by letter. The programme is due to begin for parents and children on Monday December 2nd. and applications close on October 18th.

November Dead List 2024 – As you know we have a long standing tradition of praying for our deceased relatives, friends and fellow parishioners during November, with a service for all three parishes in Hinckley on Sunday November 10 at 6.00pm. If you wish to have Masses said for your families and friends who have died please take a form next weekend, return it with an offering and the names will be posted in our churches
