Blessed Jerzy Popieluszko – this weekend is the 40th anniversary of the murder of Fr. Jerzy, an event which was to prove more than a little pivotal in the eventual fall of Communism in Eastern Europe. He has a very special place not only in the hearts of all Polish people but also in many people here, as we presented the play of the story of his life and death on the 25th anniversary of its premiere in 2011. The play, "Ksiadz", was written by Fr. Frank in 1985 and presented in West Bridgford, Nottingham in 1986. We welcome visitors to our Saturday evening Mass to mark the occasion - please join us for refreshments afterwards - and also on Sunday afternoon at 4.00pm, when the DVD of our 2011 production of 'Ksiadz' will be shown in the centre.
